Wright (Pete) Farmer was born on March 7, 1931 in Caruthersville Missouri. He was the son of Sonny and Elsie Wright. On Saturday, July 6, 2019, Farmer Wright exchanged his earthly home for his heavenly home, peacefully at the age of 88.
