Per Roberts request he asked that there be no funeral services. Burial will be at Woodland Cemetery.

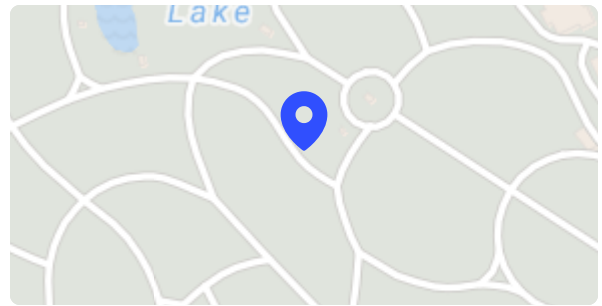

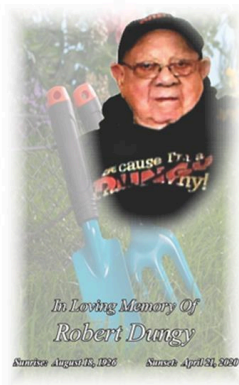
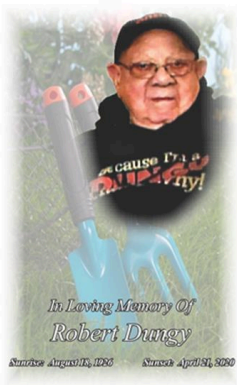
