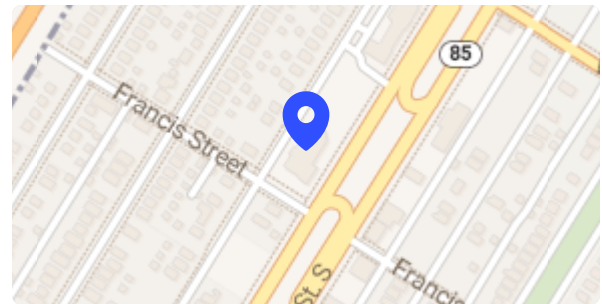
'Foodies' and loved any and all things food. You could always count on them to know where all the great food was located.

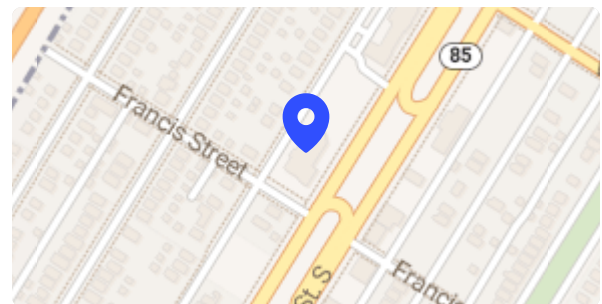

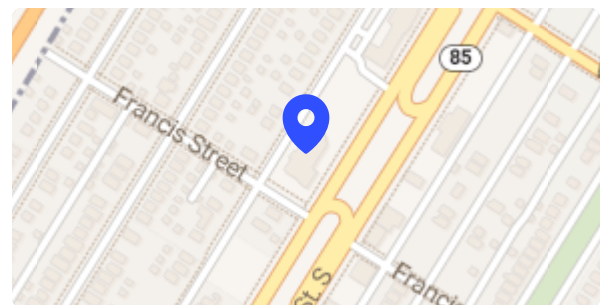

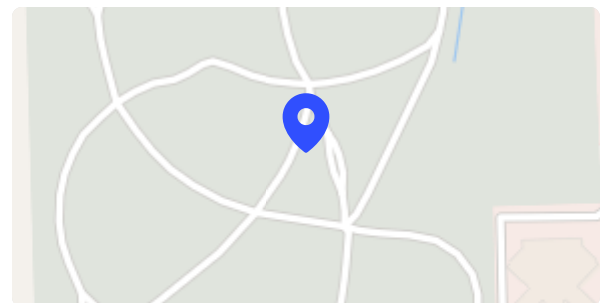
